**POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS ON LENZIE ROAD**

It has come to KI's attention that there are likely traffic delays on Lenzie Road around the Council Headquarters (Tom Johnston House) from Monday 9th March for three weeks.


Work will be carried out on Lenzie Road at the Southbank Link Road to construct a new junction. Throughout the three week period, traffic will be managed using manually controlled three-way temporary traffic lights. Pedestrians will be safely diverted onto the road.

The work being done includes: kerbing works; road surfacing and lining; and the protection and installation of utility and traffic signal apparatus.
