**INDUSTRY STREET BRIDGE CLOSURE**

We have been notified by the contractor that due to complications with the construction of the new Industry Street Bridge and associated public diversion works, the opening of the bridge will not take place by the end of October as first envisaged.

The reason for not meeting the programme relates to design and technical approval of features which were altered during the course of the works as a result of unforeseen aspects of the site.

The contractor has applied to East Dunbartonshire Council Roads Department for a one-month extension of the temporary road closure order which is required to facilitate construction of the new bridge. In applying for an extension, the contractor is targeting the completion of the work in advance of the end of November.

We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause to commuters and in particular to the residents of Industry Street and Woodhead Avenue.
