SUSPENSION OF WORKS


Due to the recent cold and snowy weather the Contractor for the Kirkintilloch Link Road has decided to suspend most works on the Kirkintilloch Link Road until working conditions improve. The reasons for this decision are;

- It is currently impossible for the Contractor to provide his workforce with safe access to the site and safe working conditions
- Many of the work activities which are currently programmed cannot be carried out in low temperatures e.g. concrete placement and assessment of insitu materials in their natural (i.e. unfrozen) state
- The quality of some work carried out in low temperatures cannot be guaranteed as temperatures rise

The Contractor will maintain a small squad on site to carry out essential works and to maintain the security and safety of the site. The situation will be reviewed daily until a decision on a return to normal working is made. Based on current weather forecasts it is anticipated that it could be around 10 days before normal working can resume.
