
EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE AT WOODILEE ROAD

Further to our Newsletter No. 29 giving details of the construction of the new roundabout and traffic signal junction on Woodilee Road, we have been advised that the temporary road closure and temporary traffic signals required to carry out these essential works has been extended for an additional period of one week, from Sunday 18th April 2010 until Sunday 25th April 2010.

Everyone involved is aware that this closure causes significant inconvenience locally, especially at peak times when traffic can be quite slow on Lenzie Road which is the main alternative route. The one-week extension is required because the Contactor discovered shallow public utility services (gas and water) unexpectedly in the existing road. These services were not identified by the PU companies at the design stage. As a result the levels on the roundabout have had to be raised to accommodate them.
