**KIRKINTILLOCH LINK ROAD
NOTIFICATION OF TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT AT NEW LAIRDSLAND
ROAD ROUNDABOUT**

As you may be aware, it is proposed to replace the existing Industry Street Bridge as part of the construction works for the Kirkintilloch Link Road. Before the old bridge can be demolished all of the public utility services in the bridge need to be either protected or diverted. In the case of gas services it is proposed that a new route be taken via Waterside Road and Parliament Road before rejoining the existing pipeline at the Industry Street / Townhead / Lenzie Road junction.

Scottish Gas Networks have informed Kirkintilloch's Initiative that they intend to start work on this diversion on Monday 8 September 2008. The works are expected to last between 8 and 10 weeks.

The gas pipeline diversion will run along the south side of Waterside Road and Parliament Road. In order to ensure the safety of his operatives during these works the Contractor will need to operate various traffic management arrangements. For most of the duration of the works the main effect will be a narrowing of the approaches to the roundabout at Waterside Road / New Lairdsland Road / Parliament Road. As a result some disruption to the flow of vehicular traffic is unavoidable. The Contractor has been instructed to do everything in his power to keep any disruption to an absolute minimum.
