
**KIRKINTILLOCH LINK ROAD
ACCESS TO INDUSTRY STREET BRIDGE**

On Monday 16 March until Wednesday 18 March between 9.00am and 4.00pm the Link Road contractor will be delivering heavy equipment to the Industry Street Bridge site. This equipment is required to progress the demolition of the existing bridge and construction of the new bridge and includes a piling rig, a crane and associated materials. The rig and the crane will be transported on long, relatively slow moving vehicles which have limited ability to manoeuvre around parked cars.

The access route will be from the west side of Industry Street via the signal junction with Townhead / Lenzie Road / Parliament Road. Your assistance in easing the delivery of this equipment would be much appreciated. This can be provided by ensuring that cars are only parked on one side of Industry Street, as is normally the case. The Contractor will seek to ensure that a clear route is available by discussing parking directly with residents on site where necessary. However it will greatly assist the process if any parking on the south side of the street and short term double parking could be avoided for these two days.

I thank you in advance for your cooperation and apologise for any inconvenience that these essential deliveries might cause to you.
