
**TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT AT NEW LAIRDSLAND ROAD ROUNDABOUT,
KIRKINTILLOCH – 22 JULY TO 3 AUGUST 2009**

The contractor for the Kirkintilloch Link Road will shortly be constructing a new drainage outfall for the Link Road. The new pipes associated with this outfall need to cross the existing roundabout at the junction of New Lairdsland Road, Waterside Road / Industry Street and Parliament Road. In order to carry out these works safely it will be necessary for the contractor to control the flow of traffic through the roundabout using temporary traffic lights throughout the period of the works (22 July to 3 August). The temporary traffic lights will be manually controlled from 7.00am to 7.00pm each working day in order to minimise inconvenience to the travelling public. The attached plan shows the proposed arrangements.

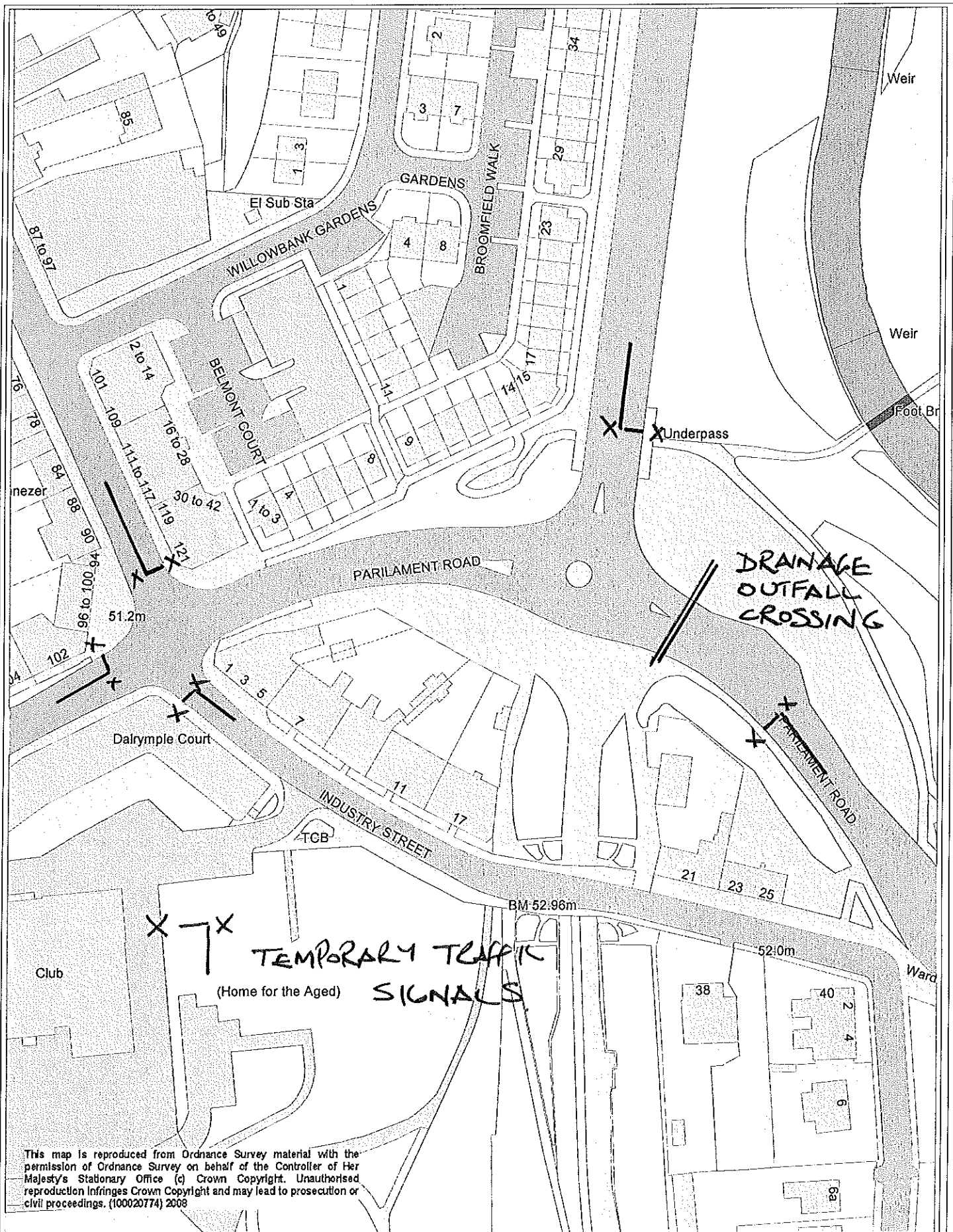
KI recognises that this type of work can be inconvenient and is doing everything it can to minimise adverse impacts. The works have been programmed to take place during the school summer holidays which is a period of lower traffic flows. They have also been coordinated with other works to ensure that local journeys are only affected by one set of traffic management works.

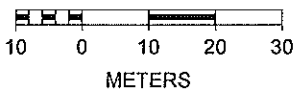
