**EARTH MOUNDING AT LINDSAYBEG ROAD  
UPDATE ON EARTHWORKS ACTIVITY**


In Newsletter No. 17 (26 June 2009) I undertook to provide residents with a copy of a plan showing the final layout of the earth mounding which is to run parallel to Lindsaybeg Road. I am now in a position to provide you with this plan, which is enclosed. You will see from this that the earth mound will be a maximum of 4 metres above the existing level of Lindsaybeg Road with the highest point of the mound running adjacent to Lindsaybeg Road at a distance of no more than about 15 metres from the edge of the road. Towards Blacklands Lane and Blacklands Place the mound will be graded to existing ground level at a relatively gentle slope. Finally the mound will be covered with topsoil and grass seeded.

Prior to the above works the area is being used by the Contractor to store a supply of stone for use in the road embankment being built across the Millersneuk Wetlands. These works are expected to be completed within the next 3 to 4 weeks.

Significant quantities of stone and other materials continue to be required in the area. The Contractor has therefore successfully applied to the Local Roads Authority for permission to continue to control traffic on Lindsaybeg Road using the temporary traffic signals. The Contractor expects the use of the signals to diminish gradually over the next 3 to 4 weeks but will continue to require their occasional use, probably until a different traffic management arrangement is required for the construction of the new Lindsaybeg Roundabout in the New Year. When details of the traffic management arrangements for the roundabout construction are available I will provide a newsletter on this issue.
