
INDUSTRY STREET BRIDGE CLOSURE

The Contractor working on the Industry Street Bridge has indicated to KI that he is unable to complete the works required to safely re-open Industry Street Bridge by the agreed date of 18 December 2009. The Contractor has been granted an extension of the temporary road closure until Wednesday 23 December 2009. Every effort is being made to complete the necessary works as quickly as possible. The Contractor's current programme targets re-opening Industry Street on Monday 21 December.

The above delay came about because all of the necessary works were dependent on the completion of a water pipe diversion. During the diversion works Scottish Water's contractor was called away to an emergency. This resulted in a consequent delay to the Link Road works. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause to commuters and, in particular, to the residents of Industry Street and Woodhead Avenue.
